# Some key features of the Granada itinerary...

1. The co-existence of Islamic and Christian cultures during the period.
2. The **Catholic Monarchs** adapted Granada to the new models from Castile, without disposing of the Nasrid element.
3. **Charles V** carried out an architectural and urban renewal
4. In the city of Granada: Court of Justice and the University, which embody the new **trends from Italy**
5. In the **Alhambra**:
  - The **Old Royal House** was refurbished as an imperial residence
  - The old **El Partal** and **El Generalife** palaces were converted to be used as governors' residences
6. In 1527, **Charles V** carried out the construction of his **own palace**, example of high renaissance architecture, to be built.







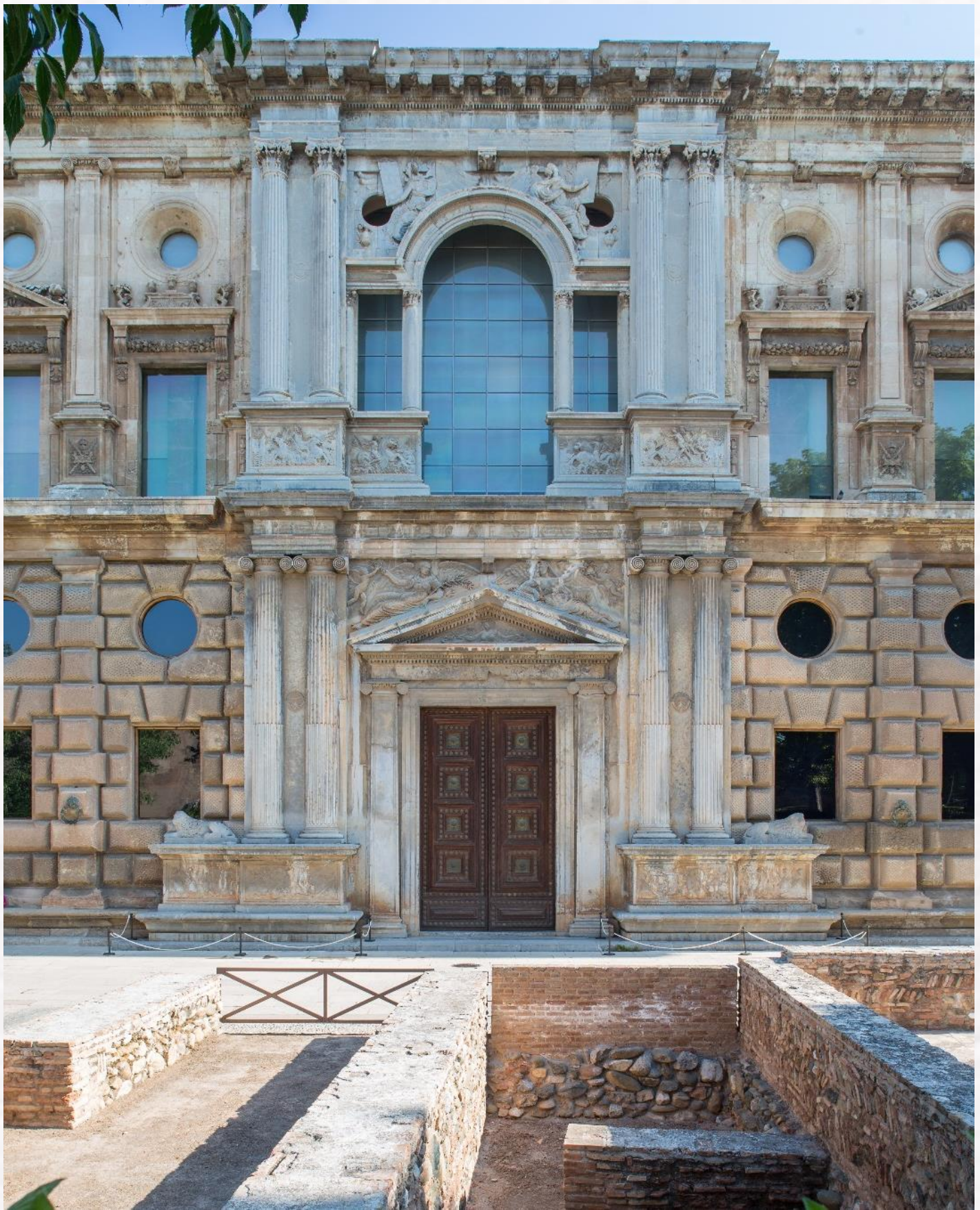
